However, the GROW program's financial position remains strong.</p> <p>GROW Coordinator informed the LGC that Manitoba Habitat Conservancy (MHC) will be doing a site visit and an audit of the WIWD's GROW program in September. Supporting documentation regarding GROW Trust Program Review and Audit Framework and Process Overview were presented to members. It was suggested by the GROW Coordinator that the LGC be present for the site visit allowing the opportunity to have a discussion with MHC regarding the GROW program.
