- Common Barberry – *Berberis vulgaris*
- Oriental Bittersweet – *Celastrus orbiculatus*
- Autumn Olive – *Eleagnus umbellata*
- European fly Honeysuckle – *Lonicera xylosteum*
- Morrow's Honeysuckle – *Lonicera morrowii*
- Tartarian Honeysuckle – *Lonicera tartarica*
- Amur Cork Tree – *Phellodendron amurense*
- European Buckthorn – *Rhamnus cathartica*
- Ural False Spirea – *Sorbaria sorbifolia*
- Tamarisk or Salt Cedar – *Tamarisk* spp.
- Siberian Elm – *Ulmus pumila*
- Amur Maple – *Acer ginnala*
- Japanese Barberry – *Berberis thunbergii*
- Russian Olive – *Eleagnus angustifolia*
- Winged Euonymus – *Euonymus alatus*
- Sea Buckthorn – *Hoppophae rhamnoides*
- Japanese Honeysuckle – *Lonicera japonica*
- Multiflora Rose – *Rosa multiflora*
