Norway Maple – *Acer platanoides*
Tree of Heaven – *Ailanthus altissima*
Common Barberry – *Berberis vulgaris*
Oriental Bittersweet – *Celastrus orbiculatus*
Autumn Olive – *Eleagnus umbellata*
European fly Honeysuckle – *Lonicera xylosteum*
Morrow's Honeysuckle – *Lonicera morrowii*
Tartarian Honeysuckle – *Lonicera tartarica*
Amur Cork Tree – *Phellodendron amurense*
European Buckthorn – *Rhamnus cathartica*
Ural False Spirea – *Sorbaria sorbifolia*
Tamarisk or Salt Cedar – *Tamarisk* spp.
Siberian Elm – *Ulmus pumila*
Amur Maple – *Acer ginnala*
Japanese Barberry – *Berberis thunbergii*
Russian Olive – *Eleagnus angustifolia*
Winged Euonymus – *Euonymus alatus*
Japanese Honeysuckle – *Lonicera japonica*
Multiflora Rose – *Rosa multiflora*
